



Volunteer Incentive Program (VIP)

2013

How it works

- All Cincinnati Cycle Club members in good standing are eligible for the VIP
- A member earns points for each volunteer activity that they support
- Points vary by type of activity (see point schedule)
- Points are reported by the Cluster Leaders on a monthly basis or by a Ride Director after a major event ride to the Board of Trustees,
- Accumulated points for all members will be reported on the CCC website and updated monthly
- At end of the year, points can be cashed in for CCC merchandise (see merchandise catalog) or donated to the CCC Advocacy Fund*
- Merchandise is giving out at Annual Dinner
- Program Runs from April 1, 2013 through October 31, 2013. Subsequent programs run November 1 through October 31 the following years.

* The Cincinnati Cycle Club has established a fund specifically for use on Advocacy related activities. Club members may donate their accumulated VIP points to this fund. For purposes of this donation, each point is equal to \$2.00

Point Schedule

Points	Activity
24*	Plan and Lead an event ride from end-to-end
14*	Plan and lead an overnight ride from end-to-end
10	Participate on CCC board as part of a non-voting committee member (e.g. Social Director, Volunteer Coordinator, Master Ride Scheduler, etc.)
6*	Plan and lead a single-day destination ride (ride listed on schedule and follows all CCC ride policies)
6	Support an event ride the entire day of the ride (e.g. SAG support, run a rest stop, etc.)
2*	Plan and lead a regular club ride (ride listed on schedule and follows all CCC ride policies)
2	Attend a board meeting as part of a trustee, cluster leader or committee member
2	Plan and host an all-club social event
1	Volunteer for at least 2 hours for any event ride, social activity, or other club related activity
1*	Support a regular club ride as a speed group lead or sweep

* This activity qualifies as part of the Certified Ride Leader Program

Certified Ride Leader Jersey = 24 points from riding activities, also requires that the candidate:

- Be a Cincinnati Cycle Club Member in good standing
- Have led at least 12 rides, meeting all responsibilities established for a Ride Leader
- Handled all logistics for ride, including planning, advertising and overall management.
- Have attended the club's Ride Leader training class
- Be nominated by a Cluster Leader
- Be approved by the Board of Trustees
